- Late students need to collect a note from the 'vie scolaire' before going to their anglophone class.



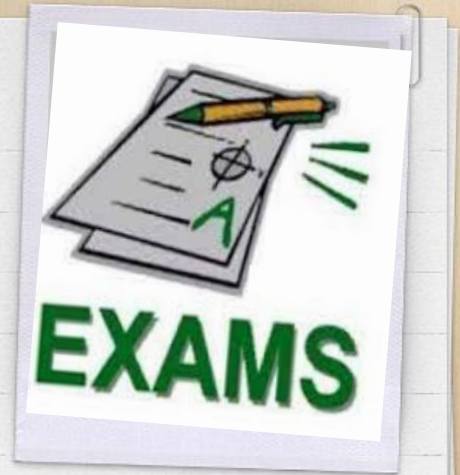
