

Dear parents,

We've seen that some students have already been busy on Seesaw over the weekend, getting to know how it works, which is great! We've allowed students free access to post and comment until now in order to get familiar with the platform. However, from today onwards, the students' posts and comments will have to be approved by the teachers and so we have asked them to only comment on other students' school work (being helpful and specific!). We will give them opportunities to communicate with each other in more structured ways through the assigned activities.

Activities will be posted on Seesaw on the mornings of the days when we usually have English lessons (i.e. for CE1 - Monday, Tuesday and Thursday mornings, and for CE2- Tuesday, Thursday and Friday mornings). They can complete the activities at any time during the week. There may also be some 'Bonus tasks' to complete that may be assigned at any time of the week.

Access Codes:

Seesaw have been quick to improve their platform and to make it more appropriate for home learning, and they have assigned each student an individual log-in code (Thank you seesaw!). This means you can either use the QR code or the individual log-in code (which is easier when logging into a laptop/computer).
