

Dear Parents,

We have all successfully reached the end of week 3 on-line learning! Congratulations! We have been trying to make the activities accessible for the students to work on independently, but being CP students, they will inevitably need your help from time to time. So thank you, parents, for helping your children to access the platforms and making the most of their activities, despite your own professional and family pressures.

Zoom:

On Monday (6th April) we would like to organise a 'virtual circle time'. This will take place on Monday afternoon at 15:00 via Zoom (group video call). This should take around 45 minutes and will give us and the students the opportunity to see and talk to each other. The teachers will set up the call and you will find the link to the Zoom below (no Zoom account needed - just click on the link, but if you are using a tablet or iPad you should download the Zoom app in advance).

The students will be placed in a 'waiting room' before the call starts, they may be asked to enter their first name before entering. To further secure the Zoom call, they will be asked for a password to enter (see below) According to data protection laws, an adult must be present during the call so we ask you to be 'in the background'. If you/your child cannot make it at 3pm on Monday don't worry, we hope to have another one soon!

A note on Seesaw:

We have had some feedback that some of you are experiencing difficulties on Seesaw, we have been too. Schools all over the world have turned to Seesaw for home learning and the platform seems to be reacting to this influx of users. We've found that refreshing the page works some of the time, but not all. We are keeping an eye on it, but think that Seesaw just needs a minute to catch up and things will be running smoothly again soon.
